



Pathways to Care is a 40 bed respite center dedicated to providing healthcare, housing, and hope to Central Florida's vulnerable homeless population of men, women and veterans in need of a safe place to heal from serious illness or injury.

Pathways to Care is a licensed assisted living facility that opened in 2003 to support their residents in achieving greater health, self-sufficiency, and housing stability. **Residents are encouraged to make a social recovery plan that will address the root cause of their illness, homelessness, and joblessness.** On average, 85% of Pathways to Care residents relocate with family or other independent living options after leaving the program.

Services Include:

- On-site case management
- Healthcare resources
- Three nutritionally balanced meals per day
- Transportation assistance to medical appointments
- Access to mental health counseling
- Referrals to community resources
- Temporary housing with 24/7 supervision and care

We collaborate with local Catholic and Protestant churches, homeless agencies and hospitals to meet the critical needs of the medically needy homeless by providing essential services with loving care.
